“I was working in a factory and was very sincere to my boss. At that time, the Lord told me often to work sincerely for him. One day when I was working in the night shift, this feeling came to me again and again. So I stopped my work, went into a room and prayed. It was then that God gave me his invitation into his ministry.

“I have chosen Exodus 34:10 as my life verse, which says ...
‘And he said, Behold, I make a covenant: before all thy people I will do marvels, such as have not been done in all the earth, nor in any nation: and all the people among which thou art shall see the work of the LORD: for it is a terrible thing that I will do with thee.’

“I have a concern for the demon-possessed people. I desire to preach the gospel to them and to pray for them. I want to encourage and help my colleagues who seem to be vexed or tired in the ministry. I have talents of singing and playing instruments, and I use these talents in ministry.

“In considering my goals for ministry, I hope to establish more churches in all the villages in my area and to establish a new branch church. I also desire to send out a missionary and one full-time worker from our church every year.
